ATTENTION: HOME CRAFT VENDORS!

The Malad Valley Welsh Festival is seeking vendors of good quality HOME ARTS AND CRAFTS for the two-day Festival in Malad, Idaho. Arts and crafts do not have to be Welsh in design. (No commercial products are allowed unless they are Welsh.)

CRAFT BOOTH FEES ARE ONLY \$30 again this year. Please read the entire application and return the signed form with your \$30 booth fee by **June 15, 2011**. Review of applications will be ongoing, and you will receive word by June 20. If your booth is not selected, \$25 of your fee will be refunded. We are hoping to not duplicate products this year; if more than one vendor applies to sell the same thing, only one will be selected.

YOU KEEP ALL BOOTH PROCEEDS. Only a limited number of booth spaces are available, so apply early. We anticipate about 1500 visitors to the Festival.

With the 4th of July on Monday after the Welsh Festival, there is a possibility of vendor booths staying open on Monday, You would need to check with the Malad Chamber of Commerce about booth fees and times related to the 4th of July. (phone #: 541-8746)

The attached VENDOR RULES AND RESPONSIBILITIES must be signed and returned with the application. Your signature indicates that you have read the rules and agree to abide by them. Please keep the second copy for your records. Failure to appear at the Festival and failure to meet all conditions as specified in the VENDOR RULES AND RESPONSIBILITIES will result in the vendor not being considered next year.

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VENDOR RULES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Craft booths must be open during the following hours:

Friday, July 1, from 11:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m.

Saturday, July 2, from 10:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m.

Vendors may set up as early as 9:00 a.m. on Friday and may stay open as late as 8:00 p.m. on both days. Failure to be open during the required hours may result in the vendor not being considered the next year.

- All products for sale must be high quality, all or mostly hand made, and under the vendor's control.
- Any products not described in this application or that do not meet the standards of the Welsh Festival will be disallowed.
- **No commercial products or catalog products will be allowed.** The only exceptions may be items related to Wales or Welsh culture/heritage.
- No food items may be sold in the arts and crafts vendor area. (A separate application is required for food.)
- A booth space is 10' x 10'. A limited number of awnings will be available, but vendors are encouraged to bring their own awnings that comply with Festival specifications. **THIS IS A CHANGE FROM PREVIOUS YEARS.** Vendors who wish to bring their own awnings/tents/trailers must consult with the craft vendor coordinator (Heidi Wright at 208-705-0849).
- Vendors must bring their own tables, chairs, signs, and display boards.
- All advertising and signs must be confined to the booth area. Every booth must have a sign large enough to read from at least 50 feet away. (Advertising brings customers!)
- Booth spaces will be assigned ahead of time; first-come, first-served does not apply.
- Only two vendors may share a booth space.
- Vendors must comply with all applicable state and federal tax laws.
- Limited parking will be available for vendors during setup and tear down times. **VENDORS MAY NOT DRIVE VEHICLES ON THE GRASS IN THE PARK.**
- Security will be provided during Friday night by the Malad Search and Rescue and Oneida County Sheriff's Department. However, vendors are encouraged to secure their products at night.
- All sales must take place from the assigned booth space and not from separate vehicles, trailers, or campers. No roving sales will be allowed.
- Vendors are responsible for keeping the booth area clean and free from trash and debris. At the conclusion of the Festival, the booth space must be completely cleared of all products and trash.
- The Festival is not dependent on the weather, although vending areas may be moved indoors in case of severe rain or cold. Extremely hot weather will not lead to changing the location of the vending area. Vendors are responsible for any weather damage to products. Fees will not be refunded because of weather problems or damage. Sometimes the wind blows!
- Electrical power will be available. Please indicate on the application form if your product or booth requires electrical power, including debit/credit card processing equipment. You must supply extension cords.
- No alcohol is allowed in the Malad City Park, the venue for the Welsh Festival.
- No pets are allowed in the Malad City Park except those required by persons with disabilities or those that are part of approved Festival activities.
- Vendors are responsible for providing their own insurance to protect against loss of product from theft, damage, etc.

I have read the above rules and responsibilities and agree to abide by them during the 2011 Malad Valley Welsh Festival.
